<b>WHAT ARE THE HAZARDS WHICH MAY CAUSE:</b>	<b>Who/what may be harmed?</b>  (give specific groups of people e.g. staff, visitors, contractors, pupils, residents, cleaners, disabled etc and estimate numbers; include significant property damage)	<b>What is done now?</b>  (i.e. provision of training, corporate and local standards complied with, existing codes of safe working practice, protective equipment, guarding, supervision, monitoring systems, specific assessments under health and safety regulations, e.g. COSHH, DSE, noise manual handling, fire etc)	<b>How bad is the risk?</b>  (It may help to use the risk assessment scoring system. Evaluate the risk as LOW, MEDIUM or HIGH)	<b>What needs to be done?</b>  (What action should be taken or needs to be considered in order that the risks identified are effectively controlled)	<b>By When?</b>  (What is the target date for completion)
Safety equipment failure	Participants/ Instructor	Daily safety checks by instructor. Karabiners, Bungee Cords Harnesses and winch cables checked prior to use.	LOW	Instructor trained in safe practices	Ongoing
Injuries to waiting participants	Participants/ Instructor	Waiting participants kept at a safe distance behind barriers. Loose objects secured/removed (including spectacles)	LOW	Constant supervision of waiting participants. Barriers used for crowd control.	Ongoing
Suspension injury from dangling jewellery, security tags or loose clothing	Participants	Participants requested to remove or secure dangling jewellery and security tags. Loose clothing should be secured or removed if appropriate.	LOW	Good observation by instructor of potential hang-up danger. Constant supervision.	Ongoing
Injuries occurring whilst bungee trampoline is unsupervised	Participants	Winch motors disabled by disconnection of power supply. Out of hours – Security staff observation of bungee equipment (if available on site)	LOW	Ensure no unauthorised access to the bungee equipment	Ongoing
